The Commission the month's disbursements and financial report. Ashton moved to approve the disbursements. Churchill seconded the motion and it carried.

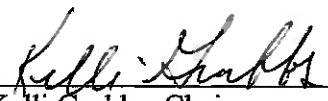
Other Business
