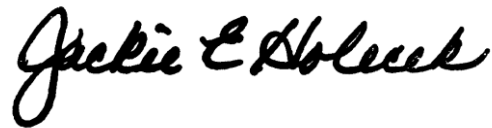

ORDINANCE for Case No. ROW17-06: Request of the City of Davenport for the right-of-way vacation (abandonment) of 10,800 more or less, of public right-of-way south of the west terminus of Dugan Court and north of the west terminus of the right-of-way south of Dugan Court. [4th Ward]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVENPORT, IOWA:

Section 1. The following described unit of Scott County, Iowa real estate is hereby vacated (abandoned). The property has the following legal description:

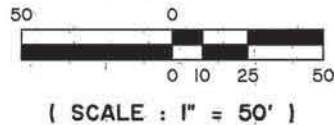

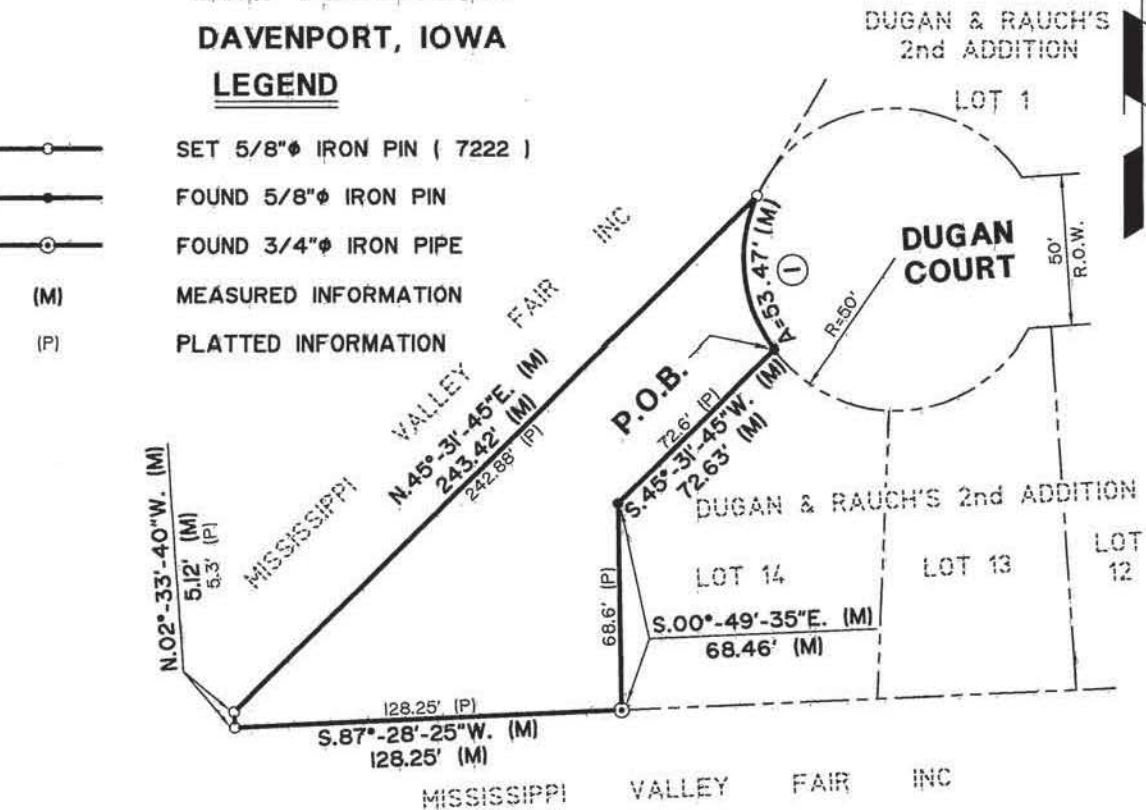

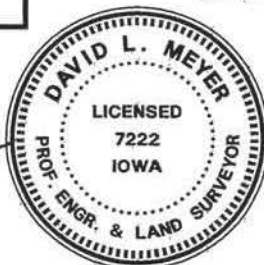

Background:
The Eastern Iowa Industrial Center, a Certified Site through the State of Iowa, has seen significant investment in the past three years, with both Sterilite Corporation and Kraft Heinz building new state of the art manufacturing facilities in the park, in addition to other investment in new facilities by 7G Distribution and Helmsing Trailer. In addition to the development in the Eastern Iowa Industrial Center, the City of Eldridge is in the process of developing an industrial site in conjunction with the Iowa Economic Development Authority on the north side of Slopertown Road.

The result of both current and future development within the Eastern Iowa Industrial Center and the Eldridge site has been a significant increase in traffic along Slopertown Road. Previous improvements to Slopertown Road between Division Street and Hillandale Road have been funded through RISE grants related specifically to the Kraft and Sterilite developments. The portion of Slopertown Road between Harrison Street and Division Street will need to be fully reconstructed in order to adequately serve the increase in traffic related to the current and future development of both industrial parks.

The estimated cost of these improvements is approximately \$1,750,000. The City of Davenport, in conjunction with the City of Eldridge, is applying to the Iowa Department of Transportation's Revitalizing Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) grant program to help with the cost of these improvements. This project is eligible to apply for the Local Development portion of the RISE program that will cover 60% of costs (with an estimated award of \$1,050,000) The RISE program requires a matching contribution. The City of Davenport and the City of Eldridge will split the required match of \$700,000 and each will contribute \$350,000.

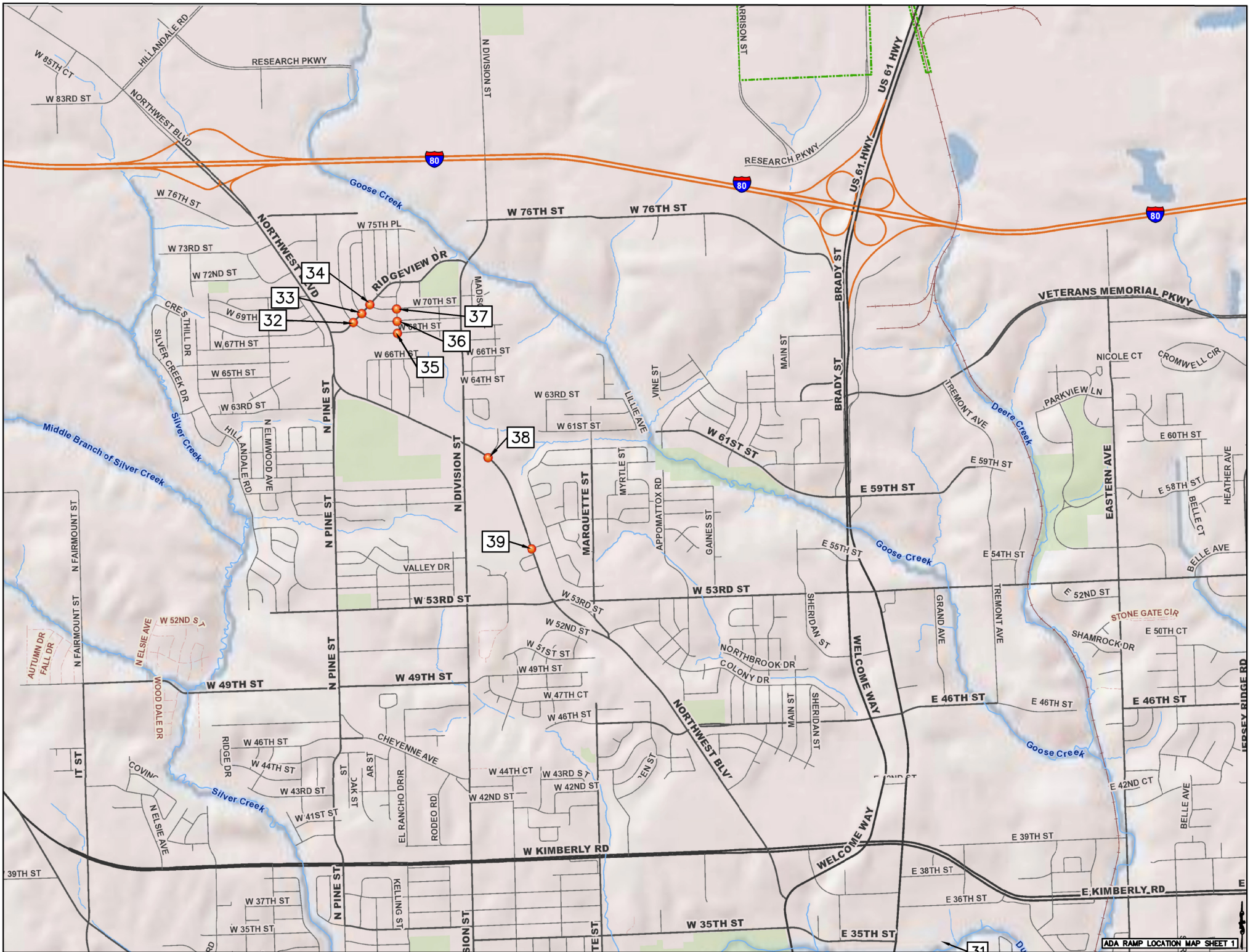

An analysis of the Series 2010A, Series 2010B, and Series 2010C bonds indicates such an opportunity. Based on the current market, the issuance of these refunding bonds would provide total savings of \$204,751 and present value savings of \$187,019. The bond sale will be held on March 14, 2018 if the market remains favorable. If the market does not remain favorable, the sale of these bonds would be cancelled. The required public hearing was held on Wednesday, January 17, 2018.

Making provisions for the issuance of not to exceed \$12,000,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Davenport, in Scott County, Iowa (the “City”), in the performance of its corporate functions as prescribed by the laws of the State of Iowa and the Charter of the City, has previously issued its General Obligation Corporate Bonds, Taxable Series 2010A (the “Series 2010A Bonds”), and, in the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Series 2010A Bonds, the City reserved the right to call for early redemption as of June 1, 2018, the maturities of the Series 2010A Bonds coming due after June 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City, in the performance of its corporate functions as prescribed by the laws of the State of Iowa and the Charter of the City, also has previously issued its General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2010B (the “Series 2010B Bonds”), and, in the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Series 2010B Bonds, the City reserved the right to call for early redemption as of June 1, 2018, the maturities of the Series 2010B Bonds coming due after June 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City now proposes to issue not to exceed \$12,000,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds (the “Refunding Bonds”) in order to pay the cost of refunding the outstanding balances of the Series 2010A Bonds, Series 2010B Bonds and Series 2010C Bonds, and has published notice and held a hearing thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Davenport, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. All objections received or made at the hearing are hereby overruled, and the Refunding Bonds are hereby ordered to be issued in the future in a principal amount not to exceed \$12,000,000.

The Refunding Bonds shall bear interest, shall be payable as to principal and interest on the dates and in the amounts, may be subject to prepayment prior to maturity and may contain such other terms and provisions as shall be determined by the City Council at the time the Refunding Bonds are sold.

Section 2. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
