 - On motion by Commissioner Guster, seconded by Commissioner Boyd, with opposition from Commissioner Pokora, the Commission voted to submit recommendations regarding the Decriminalization of Low-level Offenses to the State Legislature.
 - On motion by Commissioner Guster, seconded by Commissioner Boyd, all Commissioners voted to move forward with the recommendations regarding Decentralization of Decision-making.
 - On motion by Commissioner Boyd, seconded by Commissioner Mateos, all Commissioners voted to recommend that the City Council enacts an Unbiased Policing Ordinance similar to the one enacted by the Des Moines City Council.

Director Lacey will forward these recommendations to the Davenport City Council.
