ORDINANCE NO. **2024-329**

ORDINANCE FOR CASE ORD24-03 BEING THE REQUEST OF GRACE REAL ESTATE TO AMEND THE PRINCIPAL USE STANDARDS IN SUBSECTION 17.08.030(V) NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF DAVENPORT, IOWA BY ADDING DAY CARE CENTER AS A PERMITTED USE WITHIN A NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVENPORT, IOWA:

Section 1. That Subsection 17.08.030(V) Neighborhood Commercial Establishment of the Municipal Code of Davenport, Iowa be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. The following non-residential uses are permitted within a neighborhood commercial establishment:

- a. Art gallery
- b. Arts studio
- c. Day care center
- d. Office
- e. Personal service establishment
- f. Restaurant
- g. Retail goods establishment:
 - i. Retail sales of alcohol is prohibited.
 - ii. Retail sales of tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, and vaping and tobacco smoking accessories and supplies is prohibited.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any of the provisions of this ordinance are for any reason illegal or void, then the lawful provisions of this ordinance, which are separable from said unlawful provisions shall be and remain in full force and effect, the same as if the ordinance contained no illegal or void provisions.

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective after its final passage and publication as by law provided.

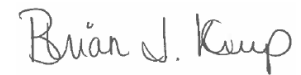
